### Warren Chang Oil Portrait Workshop

January 25–26, 2020 SWA Art Center

Warren Chang will be teaching his art workshop at the SWA Gallery. Mr Chang is an internationally acclaimed artist and has instructed drawing and painting at leading art colleges for over 20 years.

In this workshop you will be painting 1-2 portraits of the live model. Instructor demos will include painting with a limited palette, anatomy, proportions, light and shadow and hard and soft edges.

Chang has become renowned for his art, earning many awards and honors, including induction as Master Signature member of the prestigious Oil Painters of America, one of only 50 to receive this honor. His awards also include Best of Show awards in the Salon International in 2003 and the Raymar Contest in 2009. In addition, his work has been profiled in many publications, including the covers of American Artist and International Artists magazines accompanying his articles on instructional painting.

A native San Franciscan, Guy Magallanes is self-taught and has painted since childhood. His Grandmother knew he would be an artist because he was more involved in painting the walls and curtains with his food—rather than eating it! Guy made the decision to finally call himself an artist in 2000 and made the transition into a full-time artist in 2007.

### **Directions to SWA San Bruno**

From 280: take the San Bruno Exit east (towards the Airport). At San Mateo Avenue (approximately 1/4 mile) turn right on San Mateo Avenue.

**From 101:** exit San Bruno Avenue west over the freeway. San Mateo Avenue is immediately after the CalTrain elevated track, turn left. Caltrain station is two blocks south on San Mateo Avenue.
