In Memory of Judy Puccini

We are sad to announce the passing of our dear friend and fellow SWA member, Judith (Judy) Puccini who passed away on July 22 after a brief illness. Judy was a member of SWA for many years and served on both the San Francisco chapter board as Vice President and the Board of Trustees as Vice-Chair.

Judy spent her life helping others in her community. She worked at Capuchino High School for 16 years becoming Executive Assistant to the President before retiring in 2006. After her retirement, Judy helped found the Capuchino Alumni Association and worked tirelessly to write grants and obtain funding for their mission to support students with art and music programs, scholarships and mentoring programs.

Call for Art

The Society of West-Coast Artists, formerly known as Society of Western Artists, changed our name almost two years ago to better represent our location and correct the misconception of being a "western style" art group.

SWA's Board of Directors has approved a design change for our website to include new artwork and logo (our logo is a design font style of "Society of West-Coast Artists").

This call for art is for all SWA members to paint a banner style painting:

- with a ratio of 4:1 or 5:1 (16:4 or 15:3 etc.)
- reflects the west coast of California
- any medium- we want to showcase the diversity of our members' artistic style
- representational or non-representational artwork
- the logo will likely be superimposed on the artwork

A select committee will choose one piece of artwork to be the "header" on the HOME page of our website. Other chosen pieces of artwork will be used as the header on subsequent pages of our website such as MEMERS ONLY or EXHIBITS etc. This <u>Call for Art</u> is an opportunity for your artwork to be featured.




