Hi, Everyone,

We had a wonderful turnout for our Annual Reception on Sunday. The exhibit looked great and all the artists who hadn't seen it after it was hung were quite impressed with how beautiful it looked.

SWA is having a Guest Show at the Center from August 4th–12. Five artists, including four SWA members are renting out the Center to have a personal show. This is a non-SWA exhibit and the artists can hang and show whatever fine art they choose. The Center will be available for several more sessions in December. If you would like to have your own exhibit, SWA members have first shot at this. After that, we will open it up to the general public. The Center rent will be \$500 so if five members want to have a show then the cost will be \$100 each. Another \$100 will be charged for any additional artists. This is a great opportunity to showcase your works or fine art pieces with other artists. The added benefit is that these Guest Shows will bring new visitors to the Center, enhancing our visibility in the community. Speaking of visibility, I recently did a count of the number of visitors we've had since 2012. In the first four months (April–July) the number of visitors to our new Center has increased by 43%, compared to our Redwood City location. We're doing great in San Bruno!!!!!!!!

Linda Salter

Pastel Portrait Painting

Since retiring as Chancellor of West Valley-Mission Community College District in Santa Clara over a decade ago, Linda Salter has devoted herself to pursuing her interest in art. She has studied with a number of artists who teach at local colleges and at Gage Academy in Seattle. She exhibits her work at Portola Art Gallery and has a studio at the Peninsula Art Institute in Burlingame. Linda works primarily in pastels and oils and is especially drawn to portraiture. She has exhibited and received awards at several community and college art shows and has had solo shows at Portola Art Gallery, Avenue 25 Gallery in San Mateo and Esalen Institute in Big Sur.

Linda will demonstrate portraiture in pastel pencil on sanded paper. It's an interesting technique—the sanded paper allows you to layer colors so that the colors underneath subtly show through. It is a difficult technique to demo because it takes a long time so Linda will bring several partially completed portraits so that observers can get a sense of the progression.

Landscape Oil Painting

Ellen Howard works primarily in oils and pastels. She loves plein air painting because it allows her to be outdoors, taking in all the beautiful diversity of the Northern California landscape. True enjoyment comes from painting the marshlands and highlighting areas along the Pacific Coast, capturing the light as it spreads across a scene.

Ellen began taking art classes in 2005. She has studied with artists in the California Academy of Painters, Palo Alto Art Center and Pacific Art League and with noted artists Jim Smyth, Brigitte Curt, Will Maller, Jeanette LeGrue and Bill Davidson. Ellen has received two first place awards and a third place award from SWA. She was accepted into the Triton Museum of Art's 2013 Statewide Painting Competition. Her painting, "Golden Light," was chosen to advertise Filoli's exhibition: "Through the Lens: Nature Interpreted," and was published in Gentry Magazine in August 2012. Ellen is a member of SWA, California Art Club, Los Gatos Art Association, American Impressionist Society and American Women Artists.
